 *Limited places available for children who are not on all inclusive fees, offered on a first come first served basis.

Early fees Pre-booked only at £4.00 per half hour, available 7.30 – 8.00am

Late fees Available 6.00 – 6.30pm
 £6.00 per half hour (24 hours notice)
 £10.00 per half hour (booked on the day)
 £20.00 per half hour (unbooked)

Sibling discount 50% - for 2nd child when two children under 2½
 20% - for 2nd child when oldest child is 5 and under
 15% - for 2nd child when oldest child is 6 and above
 15% - for third child

Introductory Discount Sibling Discount is applied to the tuition fee only.
 There is an introductory discount when families introduce a new family to school for both the new family and the introducing family. This will be £500.00 for full time or pro-rata for part time.

Nursery Education Grant Nursery Education Grant is deducted from annual fee for all eligible children aged 3 & 4 years.

Meals All meals are included for children over one year. (No reduction in fees is allowed for children over 6 who prefer to bring packed lunches).

Basis of charges

- Fees are calculated over 34.6 academic weeks this year
- In addition there are 10 weeks and 3 days of holiday playscheme
- Fees are payable in advance, either by monthly direct debit on the first day of the month, or termly in advance on the first day of each term
- If payment of fees is not made on the due date interest of 10% is added
- Sibling discount will be given on the tuition fee element only
- For those who enter mid-year, the fees are calculated according to the date of entry, from any half term, and therefore monthly payments may differ from those printed on the fees sheet
- Alterations to lunch arrangements may only be made at the start of a new term (there is no charge for packed lunches)
- There is no reduction in fees if a child is absent
- Parents who arrive after 6.00pm (or 6.30pm if that is their normal time for collection) are charged £20.00 per half hour, or part of a half hour, per child, unless they have pre-booked
- Fees are subject to an increase at the start of each academic year

Illness and Medicines

- Children who are ill should remain at home
- Children suffering from sickness and/or diarrhoea should stay away for 24 hours after the symptoms cease
- Medicines, including inhalers, may be given to children if necessary. These should be handed in at the office and the medicine book should be signed
- Parents who are not contactable by telephone, in the case of a sick child or in an emergency, will be charged £10 after one hour and £10 for every subsequent hour, until they arrive.

Notice period

- One complete term's notice of removal from the Pre-Preparatory Department should be given by letter to the Headmistress, to expire at the end of a term
- Failure to give the required notice will result in one term's fees being charged in lieu of notice

Attendance

- The school day is from 9.00am to 3.30pm
- Requests for absence during term time should be made by letter to the Headmistress
